Chocolate Orange Cover

Resources

- 4 mm hook
- Stylecraft Classique DK Cotton;
 - White
 - Dove
 - Seville
- Black post Buttons (diff. sizes)
- Terry's Chocolate Orange

Abbreviations (UK terms)

- dc** - double crochet
- inc** - increase by working 2 double crochet in the same place
- dc2tog** - decrease by working 2 double crochet together
- st** - stitch, generally referring to the stitch in the previous row
- slst** - slip stitch
- ()** - pattern in round brackets to be repeated
- []** - number of stitches at end of round

Cover

Work in rounds, starting with White

R1: 6 dc into a magic ring [6]

R2: (inc) 6 times [12]

R3: (inc, dc) 6 times. Change to Dove [18]

R4: (inc, 2 dc) 6 times [24]

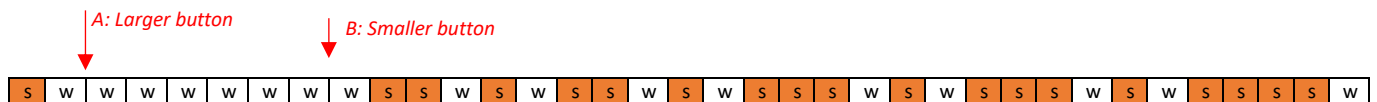
R5: (inc, 3 dc) 6 times. Change to White [30]

R6: (inc, 4 dc) 6 times. Change to Seville [36]

R7: dc in each st. Change to White [36]

R8-13: dc in each st. Change to Seville [36]

R14: dc in each st. following the colour chart.



Change to Dove

R15: dc in each st. Change to White [36]

R16: (dc2tog, 10 dc) 3 times [33]

R17: 4 dc, (dc2tog, 9 dc) 2 times, dc2tog, 5 dc, [30]

Fasten off and sew in ends.

Make up (see Fig.1)

Sew larger button in line with point A of row 14 but 4 rows above.

Sew smaller button in line with point B of row 14 but 2 rows above.
